What's Happening?

- Have not heard from Norris Designs on behalf of the current developer for the proposed RV redevelopment on the 6800 Kilmer St landfill
- No new information on City's etrakit site
- GotSneakers fundraiser
 - shipments of sneakers sent
 - received check for \$45 for first shipment
 - awaiting payment on 11/1 for 4 additional shipments
 - **FINAL GotSneakers pickup on Saturday October 7**
 - place donations at your individual mailbox area between 9am-1pm
 - if you want to donate sneakers but are not available on Saturday, the red/black bin under the lilac bush by driveway is available at McCarthy's 6688 Kendrick
 - donation bin at Colorado Tap House will be removed this weekend
 - awaiting November payout---should be greater than this month's
 - THANK YOU 😊 to all who parted with comfortable sneakers---while the initial financial amount does not seem significant, anticipated checks will add \$\$ to our legal fund; FS neighbors donated 27 pairs and more than half of the sneakers collected came from donations at the Colorado Tap House--- the fundraiser increased awareness with neighbors using Ralston Creek Trail and the impact of a proposed development to the environmental stability of the area
